What is Kelly InfoExpress for Graduate Students?

Eligible students can submit a request for an electronic copy (PDF) of *any journal article or book chapter available in print the Kelly Library*. Kelly Library staff will copy the article/chapter and send it to you by e-mail (subject to copyright regulations).

Who can use Kelly InfoExpress for Graduate Students?

This service is designed exclusively to support the research of graduate students whose department is located on the campus of the University of St. Michael's College.

How long will it take?

You will normally receive an acknowledgement of your request the next business day. If the article/chapter is available, you will receive a PDF within four business days.

What will I receive from you?

We will send you an email with an attached PDF file. We create searchable PDFs which means that you can search the PDF for a particular word or phrase and also select and copy passages of text for block quotes.

What won't Kelly InfoExpress for Graduate Students do?

We can only supply PDFs of journal articles and book chapters which are available in the Kelly Library. If you need an article/chapter that isn't available at UofT, we will provide you with information on how to obtain the material through Interlibrary Loan.

We will only respond to requests for copies of *specific* items. If you need help with your research or finding material on a particular topic, please make an appointment with the Research Help Centre.

Copyright compliance.

Section 29 of the Copyright Act permits "fair dealing for the purpose of research or private study". Section 30.2 (1) of the Act allows "a library, archive or museum or a person acting under its authority to do anything on behalf of any person that the person may do personally under section 29".

The Kelly Library will create a single copy of an article or book chapter for a student (subject to copyright limitations on length). That copy may only be used for the purpose of research or private study. It may not be posted on a website, or distributed to other people.
