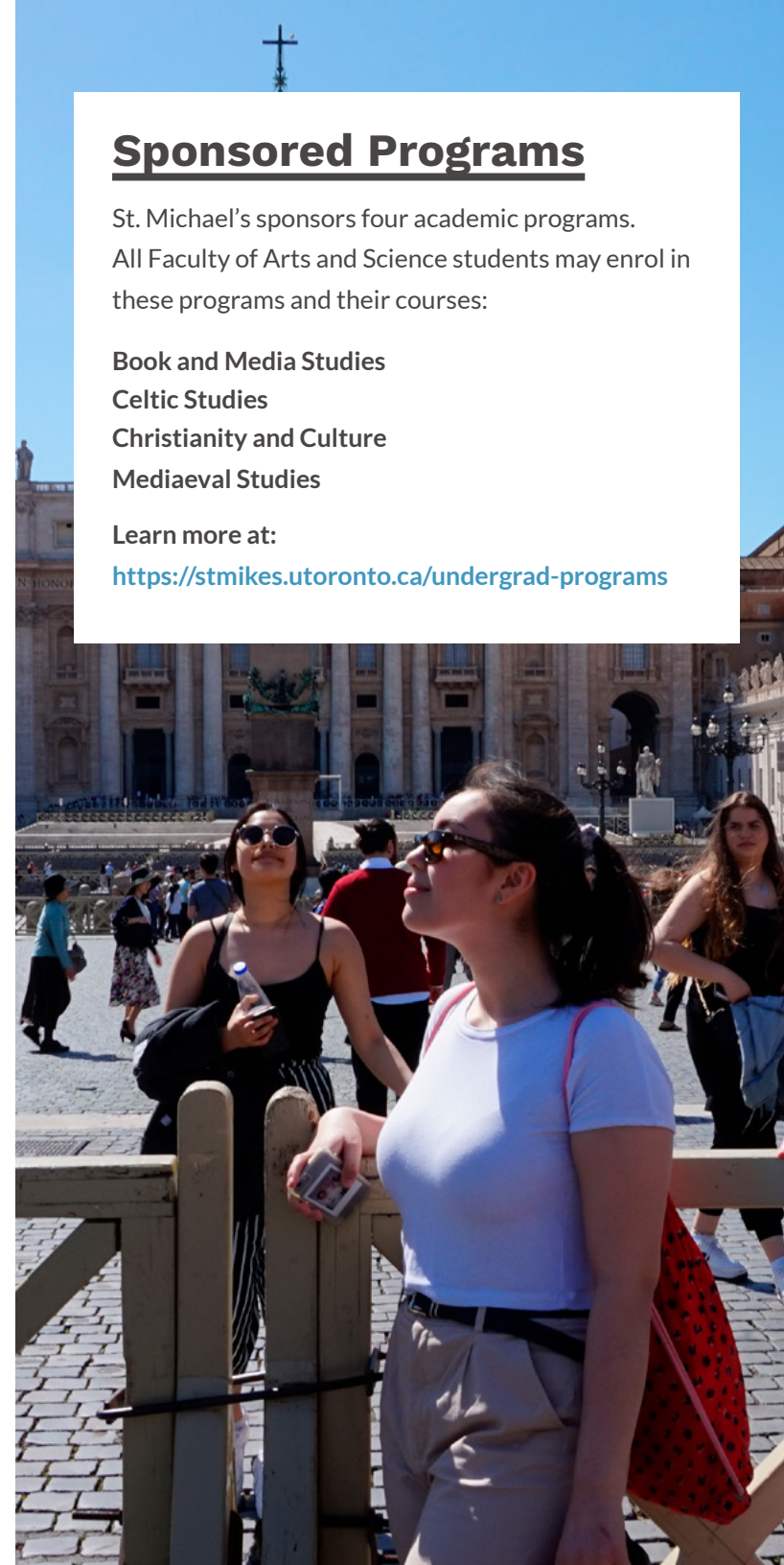

When ranking U of T's seven colleges on your OUAC application, **select St. Michael's College as one of your first three choices.**
