

## St. Michael's College Junior Fellowship Program

St. Michael's College is pleased to announce that it will be engaging young scholars through a newly established Junior Fellows program. Professional students, graduate students, or advanced-degree graduates who have a substantial connection to the University of Toronto, and who seek to participate in and contribute to the University of St. Michael's College and its community will be eligible for Junior Fellowships; applications from students at other universities may also be considered. Fellows will be selected based on academic achievement and the potential contributions that they envision making to the common life, mission, equity & diversity, and the Catholic identity of the College. In return for various forms of service to the College and active participation in the intellectual, spiritual, and social life of the College-such convening reading groups and working groups, offering mentorship and programming, participating in committee work, and other forms of contribution to Collegiate life—Junior Fellows will enjoy an annual research stipend, full library privileges, faculty mentorship and professional development opportunities, and (optimistically), access to the Faculty Dining Room and Common Rooms. The deadline for applications for the 2021-2022 academic year is August 1st, 2021.
