

REQUEST FOR EXEMPTION FROM COVID-19 VACCINE



The University of Toronto and its federated colleges require all students, faculty, librarians, and staff during the 2021-22 academic year to be vaccinated for COVID-19.

Our top priority is to support the health and well-being of all members of the U of T community as we return to our campuses. The University recognizes that for some individuals, immunization may not be possible due to medical reasons such as severe allergic reactions to vaccines or an ingredient in the vaccines.

This form is for those seeking an exemption from the required vaccination due to **medical reasons**.

Please note that approval is not guaranteed.

For faculty, librarians, and staff, Health & Well-Being Services will carefully review this form.

Incomplete submissions will not be reviewed. Be sure that the form is complete prior to submission.

For students, your campus student health & wellness office will carefully review this form.

For students in residence, in the event of an outbreak of COVID-19 in the residence(s), additional limitations may be invoked in accordance with local public health guidance in order to protect your health and the health of other residents.

You will be notified in writing if your exemption has been granted or denied.

If the exemption is approved, it will remain in effect for the duration of the 2021-22 academic year (i.e. until August 31, 2022). Individuals with an approved exemption may be required to comply with COVID-19 testing and other preventive measures as specified in the exemption approval. Such measures may be updated by later notification.

Should the exemption be denied, you will be informed as to the reasons why and will have the opportunity to submit additional information.
