AWARD DESCRIPTIONS:

Award for leadership in the arts: Student, not in their graduating year, who has led initiatives on campus to bolster the arts in the community, in the form of visual arts, music, dance, or other artistic endeavors.

Award for leadership in community and cultural development: Student, not in their graduating year, who has committed to developing cultural groups and communities on campus, with a particular emphasis on the sharing of their heritage and culture with the wider community in celebration of diversity.

Award for outstanding contribution to social justice initiatives: Student, not in their graduating year, who has led intentional initiatives to support social justice both on and off campus with special attention to the poor, marginalized, or voiceless, emphasizing the spiritual and corporal works of mercy.

Award for excellence in peer mentorship: Student, not in their graduating year, who has excelled in developing effective and supportive communication with mentees, specifically in the areas of academic, social, and mental success and wellbeing.

Award for outstanding exhibition of College spirit and pride: Student, not in their graduating year, who has displayed a joy and passion for the values and mission of St. Michael's College, and has used this passion to inspire others to a deeper love for the college.

Award for service in student mental and physical wellbeing: Student, not in their graduating year, who has excelled in creating, supporting, and fostering intentional programming targeted towards the mental and physical wellbeing of students on campus.

Award for leadership in student publications: Student, not in their graduating year, who is committed to the support of student work and writing on campus, with an emphasis on freedom of expression, challenging expectations, and advocacy.

Sr. Kathleen Heffron Award: Student athlete of the year in women's athletics at the varsity or intramural level.

Award for Men's Athlete of the Year: Student athlete of the year in men's athletics at the varsity or intramural level.

Mary H. Lee Award: Student who has demonstrated leadership in women's athletics at the varsity or intramural level.

Kevin Fawcett Award: Student in their first year of studies who has excelled in athletic achievement at the varsity or intramural level.
